Main show “Sorcière” returns this year with guest-participatory theatrical additions in an amusingly modified rendition that surpasses the last!

“Sorcière” (means witch in French), the main show performed on a 16-meter-tall massive tower stage that was extremely well received last year when it was presented for the first time, will return to the Park. Members of “The Generating Company,” a contemporary circus company based in London, and other performers will invite guests deeper into the bizarre and mysterious world of Halloween than last year with a dynamic show celebrating Halloween that will feature aerial acts, distinctive dances and songs, acrobatic performances and much, much more. Furthermore, the Park anticipates guests will be able to enjoy even more than last year a sense of unity with the show as

there will be many places in which guests can join incorporated into the show.

The annual “Trick or Treat” will be organized at specially-established venues in ten locations within the Park. Sweets will be presented to children under 11 years old, who come to the specially-established venue at the designated time and chant the customary Halloween saying “Trick or treat!” in a loud voice. With Park entertainers also participating in “Trick or Treat,” guests are sure to have a blast and loads of fun experiencing the old Halloween tradition. Moreover, a photo opportunity will be held with the globally-popular Snoopy and the Peanuts gang as well as the friends from Sesame Street appearing in costumes based on the theme of Halloween and greeting guests visiting the Park during Halloween.

In October, the Park plans to hold the annual guest-participatory fancy-dress parade, “Halloween March.” This is an event that garners great popularity every year and involves guests clad in costumes of their individual fancy having fun parading around the Park along with Park entertainers. Details will be announced at a later date.
